Itinerary at a Glance

Day 1 – December 1/ Day 2 – December 2: Welcome to Warsaw, Poland

Day 1, overnight flight to Poland. Day 2, Arrive in Warsaw and transfer to the Polonia Palace Hotel, where you'll check in and meet your Tour Director. Spend the evening at the Christmas Market just across the street for dinner, shopping, and festive lights, or relax with dinner at the hotel's restaurant.

Day 3 – December 3: Tour Warsaw, Christmas Market and Historic Old Town

After breakfast, explore Warsaw's Old Town with a local guide, including Market Square, the Barbican, and panoramic views from the Palace of Culture and Science. Warm up with Wedel hot chocolate and enjoy free time at a festive Christmas Market before gathering for dinner at Ale Gloria. **B D**

Day 4 – December 4: Polish Cooking Class & Warsaw Uprising Museum

Start the day with a hands-on cooking class, learning to prepare traditional Polish Christmas Eve dishes and sampling your creations. In the afternoon, visit the Warsaw Uprising Museum to explore the city's WWII history. Enjoy a free evening in Warsaw to revisit the Christmas Market, relax at a spa, or choose from our dining recommendations. **B L**

Day 5 – December 5: Poznan City Tour, St. Martin Croissants & International Ice Sculpture Festival

Travel to Poznan and explore the Cathedral, Old Market Square, and the Ice Sculpture Festival. Learn to make St. Martin croissants at the Croissant Museum, then enjoy an early dinner at the Christmas Market before continuing to Wroclaw. **B**

Day 6 – December 6: Wroclaw City Tour, Panorama Raclawicka & Christmas Market

Explore Wroclaw with a visit to the Panorama Raclawicka, featuring a massive painting of the 1794 Battle of Raclawice. Stroll through the festive Old Town, including Market Square, Town Hall, and the Salt Market, then enjoy a traditional Polish lunch. The evening is free to explore the nearby Christmas Market or nearby restaurants. **B L**

Day 7 – December 7: Hala Targowa Market & UNESCO Centennial Hall

Begin the day touring and shopping at Wroclaw's Hala Targowa market, followed by a visit to the historic UNESCO-listed Centennial Hall and its surrounding gardens. Spend the afternoon at leisure, perhaps revisiting the Christmas Market or relaxing at the hotel. The day ends with a dinner of traditional Polish cuisine in Market Square. **B D**

Day 8 – December 8: Tyskie Brewery Tasting & Krakow Christmas Market

Travel from Wroclaw to Krakow with a stop at Tyskie Brewery for a tour and tasting. Check in at the Golden Queen Hotel, then enjoy a stroll through Krakow's Christmas Market, with free time in the evening to explore the festive square. **B L**

Day 9 – December 9: Tour of Krakow, Krakow Historical Museum & Christmas Ornaments Decorating

Explore Krakow's beautifully preserved Old Town on a guided city tour, then visit the Historical Museum to see traditional Christmas Creches. After lunch, create your own Polish Christmas ornament, and enjoy a free evening with dinner on your own in Krakow. **B L**

Day 10 – December 10: Zakopane, Cable Car to Gubalowka Mountain & Krupowki Street

Travel to Zakopane, Poland's Winter Capital, to explore Krupowki Street, enjoy regional specialties like "oscypek" cheese, and browse a colorful local market. Weather permitting, take a cable car up Gubalowka Mountain for panoramic views of the Tatra Mountains. Return to Krakow in the evening after free time to explore, dine, or shop. **B L**

Day 11 – December 11: Christmas Cookies Baking Class & Wieliczka Salt Mine/ Day 12 – Saturday, Dec. 12

Spend the morning baking Christmas cookies and exploring the UNESCO Wieliczka Salt Mine, then enjoy a Farewell Dinner in Krakow's Market Square. **B D** The next day, savor a final breakfast before departing Krakow, with included transfers for air guests or independent arrangements for land-only travelers. **B**
