Itinerary at a Glance

Day 1 – Sunday, September 13: Departure Day / Day 2 – Monday, September 14: Welcome to Frankfurt, Germany!

Begin your journey in Frankfurt with a smooth group transfer and check-in at a centrally located 4-star hotel. Discover the city's blend of old and new on a guided tour through the historic Römerberg, the lively Old Town, and the striking financial district. Enjoy free time for lunch, then gather in the evening for a warm Welcome Dinner featuring traditional Hessian cuisine. **D**

Day 3 – Tuesday, September 15 – Rhine River Cruise & Castles

Set out on a scenic Rhine River cruise past vineyard-covered hillsides, medieval castles, and charming villages. Step into the past with a visit to an authentic hilltop castle, then enjoy a wine tasting paired with regional specialties that showcase the flavors of the Rhine Valley. **B**

Day 4 – Wednesday, September 16 – Heidelberg, Pretzel Making & Rothenburg ob der Tauber

Begin the day exploring Heidelberg's romantic Old Town and hilltop castle on a guided tour rich with history and charm. Then travel through the scenic Bavarian countryside to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, a fairy-tale town of medieval streets and half-timbered houses. Take part in a hands-on pretzel-making workshop before enjoying a traditional dinner and an overnight stay in a charming 16th-century hotel. **B D**

Day 5 – Thursday, September 17 – Neuschwanstein & Hohenschwangau Castles

Spend the day exploring the legendary castles of King Ludwig II—wander through the fairytale halls of Neuschwanstein and the historic charm of Hohenschwangau. Set against a breathtaking alpine backdrop, these castles offer a glimpse into royal life and romantic imagination. End the day in the charming town of Füssen with a traditional Bavarian dinner. **B D**

Day 6 – Friday, September 18 – Zugspitze, Innsbruck & Tyrolean Dinner and Show

Ride the cable car to the summit of the Zugspitze for breathtaking views across Germany, Austria, Switzerland, and Italy. Then head to Innsbruck for a traditional Tyrolean dinner and folkloric show before settling in lakeside at peaceful Pertisau. **B D**

Day 7 – Saturday, September 19 – Innsbruck & the Tyrolean Alps

Spend the day discovering Innsbruck's charm, from the Golden Roof and Hofkirche to the panoramic heights of the Bergisel Ski Jump. Browse the sparkling Swarovski store, then ride the Nordkette cable car into the heart of the Alps for breathtaking views. Return to Pertisau for a refined 5-course dinner to cap off this culture-rich Alpine day. **B D**

Day 8 – Sunday, September 20 – Rattenburg, Desserts & Sound of Music Tour in Salzburg

Begin the day with warm apple strudel and coffee in Austria's tiniest town, Rattenberg, before heading to Salzburg for a guided tour of its Baroque beauty and Sound of Music film sites. Sample local favorites like Mozartkugeln and Salzburger Nockerl before continuing to Munich for an overnight stay in the heart of the city. **B D**

Day 9 – Monday, Sept. 21 – Munich Tour & Oktoberfest / Day 10 – Tuesday, Sept. 22

On Day 9, start the day exploring Munich's historic heart, from Marienplatz to the bustling Viktualienmarkt. In the afternoon, dive into the energy of Oktoberfest with reserved beer tent seating, traditional Bavarian fare, and festive live music, an unforgettable finale to your Alpine adventure. **B D**.
