YOUR DAILY ITINERARY FOR LEARNING AND DISCOVERY

DAY 1 | Monday, October 18, 2027 DEPARTURE DAY

In the afternoon, after a short flight to Zanzibar Island—known locally as "Unguja" – the rest of the day is yours to enjoy at your own pace.

DAY 2 | Tuesday, October 19, 2027 TOUR OF STONE TOWN, COOKING CLASS WITH LOCAL FAMILY, SUNSET CRUISE

An immersive walking tour of historic Stone Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, led by a local guide. Weave through its maze of narrow streets, uncover a rich tapestry of influences – from Persian and Portuguese roots to the legacy of the Omani sultanate and British rule. Along the way, explore bustling markets before we visit a home and learn to prepare signature regional dishes. Tonight, we head to the shore for a magical two-hour sunset cruise aboard a traditional dhow.

DAY 3 | Thursday, October 20, 2027 JOZANI CHWAKA BAY NATIONAL PARK AND MENAI BEACH CONSERVATION AREA

We venture to Jozani Chwaka Bay National Park the sole place on Earth where you can spot the rare red colobus monkey. Stroll along raised boardwalks through lush mangrove forests as you encounter unique coastal flora and wildlife, from curious fiddler crabs to vibrant birdlife.

Then, step into a butterfly garden to witness the dazzling beauty and fascinating life cycle of Zanzibar's native species. Afterward, journey to your new lodge set along a secluded stretch of the Menai Beach Conservation Area,

DAY 4 | Friday, October 21, 2027 MENAI BAY BOAT CRUISE

Board a traditional motorboat and glide along the island's largest protected marine area, you'll be surrounded by a dazzling seascape of coral reefs, mangrove forests, and shimmering schools of tropical fish. Swim or snorkel among the vibrant marine life, then savor a picnic lunch in this idyllic island setting.
